MSU has announced the tentative fall 1995 Spartan volleyball schedule, and SideOut Club members will be among the first to see it.

Fans get a special treat this year as the Spartans play most of their pre-conference matches at home. For the last several years the team has spent much of September on the road, so many fans didn't get to see them until their home Big Ten opener.

Of special note is the fact that MSU is hosting not one, but two tournaments. This matches the total number of tournaments hosted here in the last ten years. Be sure to come out to see the non-regional teams making a rare visit.

In between those two tournaments, the Spartans take a road trip to California, to play in the UCSB Invitational Tournament. This will be the first time in fifteen years the team has been invited to California to play the strong competition there. MSU is expected to be one of the top seeds, along with hosts UC Santa Barbara, Florida, and Long Beach State.

And be sure to start the season with the casual atmosphere of the alumni match on August 26, as players from the last decade or more of Spartan volleyball return to take on this year's team.

1994 Highlights

The Spartan women's slogan for 1994 was "On the Rise", and they certainly lived up to it. Some season highlights:

- An overall record of 17-14, the team's best since 1980.
- A Big Ten record of 9-11, their best ever, with a seventh-place finish, one game out of fifth.
- Huge wins over Notre Dame (a top fifteen team) and Penn State (a Final Four team).
- An invitation to play in the NCAA tournament, the first ever for MSU.
- ♦ A new attendance record of over 800 fans at the Penn State match.

And, of course, the other major news (certainly *not* a highlight), was the loss of not one, but two setters to knee injuries. Both Courtney DeBolt and Julie Pavlus have had their torn anterior cruciate ligaments repaired. Although they won't see any playing time during the spring season, they are both expected to be at full strength for the fall.
